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
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

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Letter from the Editor

HIS PAST MONTH, I found myself at a wedding unlike any other—a celebration of love sailing down the storied Hooghly River, its inky black waters reflecting the stars and city lights of Kolkata in the distance. Against this luminous backdrop, the bride stood on the bow of the boat, her silhouette a sharp white contrast to the dark embrace of the hallowed river. ITH INDIAN WEDDINGS being long-drawn affairs, often spanning several days and taking place in exotic locales, newly married couples are so caught up with pre-wedding preparations and ceremonies that it drains them out. Once they are done with the rituals and celebrations, all they yearn for is a quick break that allows them time to just relax. This is why mini-moons have become popular. It is not the honeymoon, but an in-between break that enables couples to recoup for a few days, giving them ample time to plan a more elaborate and longer vacation later.

We have handpicked a special list of destinations that don't require more than four to five days of travel, are under 12 hours of flight time, and don't have to be exorbitantly expensive.

Minicopy Island, LAKSHADWEEP

This is one of the most exotic destinations in India, offering an unexplored option that is fast becoming a mini-mooners' paradise. It is a crescent-shaped island with one of the largest lagoons, known for its beautiful private white beaches, underwater adventures, romantic sunset walks, and a relatively quiet atmosphere, making it the ideal place to spend time with your partner in a breezy ambience surrounded by swaying palm and coconut trees and the soothing sounds of the sea. Relatively unexplored by tourists, this Grecian village is peppered with blue and white houses along with and churches with pink and ochre details, hanging on the caldera. The sunset view from Oia is incredibly romantic, and couples make it a point to watch this beautiful moment together, which makes them feel one not just with each other but also with the universe. Lying on the northwest coast of Santorini, it is just a 20 km ride from the city.





8. Le Morne Brabant, MAURITUS

Le Morne Brabant is a peninsula in Mauritius and has been declared a World Heritage site. It offers extraordinary views of the island, lagoon, and coral reefs, making it ideal for hiking or simply walking by the beach. It is also recognised as one of the best spots for kitesurfing, thanks to its steady winds and protected lagoons. If you're willing to explore the Morne Brabant mountain, which was once a sanctuary for runaway slaves, you can take up to four hours to reach the summit. However, if that's not your scene, you can simply enjoy the unique flora and fauna of the region and do your own thing. While the flight time to Mauritius is 11 hours, Le Morne Brabant is only a one-hour drive from the airport.

9. Tuscany, ITALY



There is something magical and incredibly romantic about Tuscany. It offers visitors a soothing ambience with its picturesque meadows, solitary abodes, and enchanting history. Tuscany is about visiting the languid vineyards, where you can indulge in multiple glasses of the finest wine in the region. From the stunning Maremma Hills to the golden beaches of Tuscany and the unmissable Chianti region, it is a destination every mini-moon couple aspires to visit and soak in the Italian vibe. You can fly directly to Tuscany from Delhi.



10. SEYCHELLES

A fabled island country with boulder-lined shores alongside azure waters, Seychelles is filled with granite and coral islands, offering a wide range of activities that make it a favourite among honeymooners. An archipelago in the Indian Ocean, it boasts staggering mountain rainforests and nature reserves. 

Colaba, a part of town that is usually bustling with tourists, hawkers, residents, explorers, and city walkers, especially with the holiday season is in full swing. At 6AM, the streets of SoBo seem more quiet and serene than usual, the calm before the storm if you will—the collective sound of the shoes of our crew on the pavement are perfectly synchronised, like we're soldiers in a marchpast.

As we arrive on set, our chaotic energy swallows up the silence, and the crew gets to work, striving to prepare the set before our cover star for this special issue, Pratibha Ranta, arrives. Much to our surprise, she is right on time, and in sync with us. No waiting for a star? Truly a breath of fresh air.

As I make my way to introduce myself, I find Ranta huddled over a plate of *poha* she brought along, her hair up in curlers, her morning skin radiant and unaltered. She greets me with a warmth that makes me feel like we've known each other for years.

From Shimla to the Oscars', Pratibha Ranta's meteoric rise is almost serendipitous. One might think that she appeared on the



cinema scene seemingly out of nowhere after the breakout success of her critically acclaimed debut *Laapataa Ladies*, but the truth couldn't be further from that.

"Everyone thinks *Laapataa Ladies* is my first time on screen. I think very few know of my struggling days, the years I spent doing *Qurbaan Hua* on television, or how long it took for me to finally get *Laapataa Ladies*," she quips.

We talk while she gets her glam done, the sounds of the set provide a comforting backdrop to our conversation. Ranta requests us to play Taylor Swift, beaming as soon as we follow suit.

She tells me how she absolutely loves our 'Gen-Z Bride' brief for this shoot, admiring the ensembles she is about to wear. While she doesn't plan on marrying anytime soon and admits that her idea of an ideal wedding is something very simple and intimate rather than something lavish, she shares, "Gen Z brides are all about personalisation, I really love how they are not confining themselves to conventional norms and practices. Instead, they incorporate what's meaningful to them and represents their journey to truly make their special day their own."

I can't help but see Jaya, her character in *Laapataa Ladies*, in Ranta, or maybe it's the other way around, as she says, "There's both: flower and fire". Like Jaya, Pratibha Ranta's only true desire is to make something of herself, I tell her she already has, but it seems the actor has her eyes set on the world, and with her dedication, she just might get it too.

Coming from humble beginnings in Shimla to the city of dreams, Ranta navigated a highly competitive industry all on her own, although she credits her family for being extremely supportive, admitting that while she loves the glitz and glamour of Mumbai, she would never give up her heritage, values or morals for anything. "True success is when you can be who you are, be proud of where you come from and still forge your way ahead".

I nod along. Success and stardom often appear effortless, almost as if all you need is luck and a pretty face, and the road ahead will be easy, straight, and well-lit. What often gets missed is the resilience, rejection, self-doubt, perseverance and sleepless nights behind the success stories. Once you're successful, people can't seem to see beyond the flashing lights. But for Ranta, the hard days are what make her success all the sweeter.

In a candid conversation, Pratibha Ranta opens up about her journey, the highs and lows, her thoughts on love and relationships, what she thinks of marriage, success, and her plans ahead. Excerpts from the interview:

What inspired you to pursue a career in acting, and how did your family's concerns and your early experiences in Mumbai shape your journey?

I've always been fascinated by films and cinema. It was something I really needed, and I also feel it's genetic. My grandmother was a Hindi teacher and would organise Hindi plays, and my father would watch so many films. It all just flowed to me. When I shared this decision with my family, they weren't sure about it at first. It wasn't that they thought I couldn't do it, but they were concerned for my safety.

It was definitely challenging, but my passion kept me going. I realised that if I stayed in Shimla, nothing would happen. I had to take the leap, come to Mumbai, and get into auditions.

I had no idea what to expect when I first came. It was a real struggle in the beginning, but I saw it as a learning experience. There was a lot of uncertainty, but I knew I had to be resilient.

Looking back, do you think your rebellion was a strength or did it cause doubt?

I've always been rebellious. My siblings were great at studies, but I was average. My focus was always dancing and extracurricular activities. But I realised I can't just be 'good', I have to make an impact. I realised that to make people believe in me, I actually had to do something. For a long time, I was also seeking validation in my life. I thought my rebellious nature could be a way to prove myself to my family. So, I made a personality switch. I developed a 'go-getter' attitude. I never doubted myself. I always knew that if I was able to think about this, there was a future in it.

How does it feel to work with Aamir Khan, Kiran Rao, and Sanjay Leela Bhansali so early on in your career?

It was a beautiful experience. I didn't work as much with Aamir sir, but definitely with Kiran ma'am. She has an incredible understanding of exactly what she wants from an actor, and from her team as well. With Sanjay sir [in Heeramandi], I think he's someone who really improvises during the process. You could see him thinking about where the scene was going, constantly making changes on set. He was always fully engaged in the moment, which was inspiring to witness.

Did transitioning from TV to film feel like a leap into the unknown?

When I moved from TV to films, my family was skeptical as I was giving up a stable career for uncertainty. I explained to them that I can only experiment at this time. When I took that leap, I was also very unsure. I hadn't even signed a film. There were anxious days when I wondered, 'What am I doing? Was this a good decision? Should I just pick up another TV show to at least feel secure?' But I knew that in the long run, it would be worth the risk. Today, I'm glad I took that leap.

How do you manage the duality of roles like Jaya, and what do you connect with the character on?

I think Java is a mix of both flower and fire. The flower represents her attitude towards people, how she nurtures them, and how beautifully she helps them move forward with her. The fire, however, is for herself.

It's the injustice that has been done to her. The fire is for her own cause. She says a powerful line in the film: "If we steal, we steal a chance for ourselves, from life." What that means is that all she's doing is for herself, not with the intention of harming anyone. If I have taken this opportunity, it's something I've taken from my own life. I have risked my own life to do this. It's not easy to take the plunge, but you do it. She had to break free from her small world and achieve something for herself. And I really relate to that.

How has your heritage and upbringing shaped your approach to tradition and modernity?

You know, I am very proud of my Pahadi culture and all the rituals and family values that come with it. I've grown up practising them, and they've always been around me. I think your culture is something that sets you apart from others, and I just don't understand why anyone would want to lose that. I am a proud Pahadi, and I want to say that out loud. I want to take my culture forward because it's so beautifully crafted—from the handlooms to the textiles, everything in the mountains is so stunning. These things nurture me and keep me grounded. They help me stay connected to reality and remind me that we're all just passing through.

What advice would you give to young women trying to make it in the industry today?

A lot of boundaries break when a person from a small city achieves something big. There are so many girls in Shimla who constantly message me asking for advice. Why can't anyone fulfil their dream? Of course, you can. You can think about it, but it's about getting that opportunity and the confidence. When I do something, my friends' and family's confidence also grows. If I can do it, they believe they can too. It's not about everyone coming through; it's about chances. At least, when you do something, you feel happy with yourself, which is really important. Everyone deserves an opportunity, but you have to work very hard and not give up.

How has the journey from Shimla to the Oscar's been?

Growing up in Shimla, I never imagined that one day I'd be walking a journey that leads to the Oscars. My hometown, with its serene beauty and supportive community, has always been my source of strength and inspiration. Moving to Mumbai and stepping into the world of acting was daunting at first, but it was also a dream I couldn't ignore.

I owe a lot to the people who believed in me along the way, especially for Lapaataa Ladies. To represent such a powerful narrative on a global platform like the Oscars is surreal. This journey has taught me that no matter where you come from, passion and perseverance can take you places you never imagined.

How has travel changed your life and perspective?

Travelling gives you a lot of confidence, helps you to explore yourself and understand aspects of yourself that you didn't before. You learn not only about other people and cultures, but also a lot about yourself and how you perceive the world.



BECOMING ADAM AND EVE: LUXURY FORAGING IN COPENHAGEN

The Danish tradition of foraging, coupled with the comforting embrace of 'hygge', offers honeymooners a unique culinary experience. One that helps them connect with nature's bounty and ultimately with each other, NAINAA RAJPAAL discovers

enmark's love of foraging has existed since the time of the hunter-gatherers. In the Viking Age, the tribes relied on nearby forests, seas and the wild foods within them-from mushrooms and roots to fruits and seafood.

Today, this age-old tradition is being rediscovered, especially in Copenhagen, where it is presented as a modern sensorial journeyalbeit with all the luxury the Vikings never knew.

Copenhagen is regarded as the birthplace of the New Nordic Movement, a celebration of simplicity, purity, and the resonance of local food from the land. It draws from the national philosophy of 'hygge' which has no direct translation, but roughly means 'enjoying the simple pleasures of life.' Imagine meandering into a



thick forest, plucking fresh carrots from the wet earth and fresh berries from the bushes-with your loved one by your side.

As someone fresh out of the anxieties of planning a weddingguest lists, sangeet performances and wedding shopping will do that to you—a honeymoon with hygge was the stuff of dreams.

THE FORESTS OF DYREHAVEN

The foraging adventure begins in Dyrehaven, a dense forest, just a 15-minute train ride north of central Copenhagen. It is a UNESCO World Heritage site on account of its unique cultural and natural landscape. Dyrehaven is home to around 2,000 wild deer who are surprisingly comfortable around humans. As they approach you without hesitation, you're bound to feel like the first humans to roam these lands.

Guided foraging tours, such as the ones offered by Sanketure (*sanketure.dk*) provide a luxurious introduction to the experience. Guided by a trained chef and a wild food expert, you'll start the tour by foraging for a cornucopia of mushrooms-from ovsters to umami-laden Chanterelles. Your guide will ask you to slow down, touch, smell and feel every edible plant-allowing you and your partner to truly connect with the forest's bounty.

Johannes Ruggaard, an expert forager and the founder of **Vilde Krydderier** (*vildekrydderier.dk*) also offers foraging, bonfires and workshops to travellers. Johannes says, "Foraging puts people in a primal state. You are forced to be in the present, where your natural senses are heightened. There's a fundamental shift in mindset, where you snap out of the drudgery of beeping phones and incessant reminders to connect with something far more meaningful."

Foraging is an all-season activity-summer brings with it blood-red berries and fruits, autumn brings wild mushrooms and



root vegetables, and winter brings herbs like chives, mint, sage, and thyme.

As you walk deeper into Dyrehaven, turn into treasure hunters together and try spotting the Black Trumpet Mushroom—a rare and gourmet variety, usually found to the north of the forest. When the season is right, you'll get a chance to pick juniper herbs for your glass of gin, fall fruits for jams, and elderberries for syrups.

Continue walking through the dense oak and beech forest with hidden lakes—full of swans sunbathing in the glistening waters. Go jaunting up the hill and you'll be greeted with sweeping views of the Öresund strait. Perched on top of the hill is the beautiful '**Hermitage**', one of Denmark's most iconic Baroque structures. Don't be fooled by its name though. The 'Hermitage' has nothing hermit-like about it. It is in fact, King Christian the VI's opulent hunting palace—where he invited neighbouring royals for grand game hunts and banquets.

A HYGGE MEAL IN THE WOODS

After you and your partner have explored the soft grass with your hands and unearthed herbs, tarty lingonberries, and season-friendly mushrooms, make your way to a clearing deep in the forest, where you begin preparing the starters for your five-course gourmet meal. The food is slow-cooked over fire and wood—in true Viking style.

Your culinary guides help you whisk together a feast served alongside signature Danish *smørrebrød*—flatbreads topped with herbs and artisanal cheese. Choose to pair your meal with the local alcoholic brew 'Kryddersnaps'—or 'Snaps' as the locals call it. It is infused with berries, dill, rosemary and other spices you've foraged—adding a touch of magical earthiness to every sip. The 'Hermitage' in Dyrehaven, once a royal hunting palace, now serves as a cultural landmark with sweeping views of the surrounding forest. *Below:* After foraging, guests can enjoy a five-course meal in the forest, cooked over firewood and served with traditional Danish *smørrebrød*.



Now it's time to curl up with blankets and soft cushions as you begin your supper. Dig into the spread expertly set on a rustic wooden table, decorated with lanterns that emulate the fireflies from the forest. As the bonfire crackles beside you, sit back and savour the flavours of the Scandinavian wilderness—every bite a testament to your hygge experience.

RIDE INTO THE SUNSET

As you dwell on the rich tapestry of tastes from your foraged supper, it's time for another adventure. As the golden hour sets, ride around the ancient woodlands in the most luxurious way ever—on Icelandic horses. These purebred horses are known to have travelled long distances on Viking longships owing to their resilience and sure-footedness.

The **Krathusgaard** (*krathusgaard.dk*) offers two-hour rides around the forest for ₹8,350 per person. You can choose to go with a guide or ride with your partner in complete solitude.

Alternatively, you could travel like the Danish royals did—in open horse-drawn carriages. The drivers will even customise the route based on your preferences. Rides start from ₹1,800-4,800.

After your ride, unwind with your final refreshments. Head to **Kilden i Skoven** (*kilden. kirstenpiils.dk*), a restaurant that is like an oasis in the forest, and is true to its name that literally means, 'a spring in the forest'. According to Kilden's sommelier Lea Sandby, the name refers to a healing spring that pilgrims found in the area in the year 1583. Today, she

and her team have proudly turned this water into wine. Sit back on the deck chairs and enjoy classic and natural wines from the vineyards around. Look around at the rich, unspoiled forests that make one think of the Garden of Eden, where Adam and Eve perhaps had the same experience you did foraging for wild foods, basking in the sun, dipping their feet in crystal-clear waters, and idly watching the deer graze. ⊕

HONEYMOONING in PARADISE

Henna Shah shares unforgettable experiences on her three-week honeymoon that took her from serene island life in Fiji to exhilarating adventures in New Zealand







S THE WEDDING BELLS faded and our elaborate Gujarati wedding wrapped up, my husband Yash and I yearned for a hiatus from our newfound reality. We crossed six time zones for our first stop on our long and "leave-us-alone" honeymoon,

watching the Indian winter melt into a Pacific summer in Fiji. "Bula! Welcome to Nadi, Mr. and Mrs. Merchant," beamed our

bellboy, glowing on account of his crimson undertone. I almost mirrored his complexion as I let my brand-new identity sink in. Our day began with decadent breakfasts with cerulean views, followed by a serene duo therapy at the spa that whetted our appetite for lunch. We then spent a leisurely afternoon indulging in cocktails by the pool, toasting under the blazing Fijian sun. As tropical twilight took over the skies, the resort came to life with a game of mini golf alongside fellow honeymooners, which led to a communal *Kava* ceremony, where we realised that the earthy drink was an acquired taste. Nibbling away at some cassava fries, we watched the delightful Meke dance.


At the tail end of our week in Fiji, we set foot in the glistening ocean on a kayak, trying not to lose sight of the coastline. As adrenaline renewed in our laid-back bodies, we jet-skied our way to the neighbouring Monuriki Island to uncover secluded beaches. If our 11-year love story with all its ups and downs were a movie, I would serendipitously end it here—zooming out from our time in Fiji.

However, since weddings are not happy endings but happy beginnings, our week in Fiji was the stepping stone to another two enchanting weeks spent across the sea in New Zealand.

As we refreshed our memory of Middle-Earth by watching a Hobbit movie on our flight from Nadi to Auckland, we gazed out at the rolling fields of the

North Island. Both the second week of our honeymoon and New

Zealand are best experienced on four wheels, except for Auckland, which is best navigated on foot to avoid steep parking charges. Since it was New Year's Eve, we spent our first evening in Auckland finding the perfect spot by the harbour to watch the Sky Tower light up with fireworks, ushering in the New Year in a new country. The next day began with a swig of velvety flat white at Sky Café on the 50th floor of the Sky Tower (skycityauckland. *co.nz*) while observing the city's striking skyline.

With Auckland in the rearview, our road trip came alive as While the Shaky Isles had been nothing short of heavenly,

we approached Waitomo for a three-hour blackwater rafting and cave-tubing experience through the Waitomo caves to spot the bioluminescent glowworms. We continued on to Matamata, passing fields devoid of humans and dotted with sheep, as we geared up to dive into the Middle Ages at the Hobbiton Movie Set (hobbitontours.com). Along with a refreshing gulp of the English Ale at The Green Dragon Inn, we savoured one of the best vegetarian burgers in New Zealand at The Shire's Rest. After another scenic hour-long drive, Yash surprised me with a stop at the Polynesian Spa as we entered the lake city of Rotorua. The unmistakable smell of sulphur engulfed us as we dipped into our private mineral pool overlooking the lake, soaking in the geothermal goodness that healed our long-drive fatigue. we found ourselves at Hell's Gate (*hellsgate.co.nz*) in Rotorua, witnessing the earth come alive with spitting geysers, bubbling mud volcanoes, and the earth hissing beneath our feet. After this brief tryst with hell, we grounded ourselves at Agrodome, where sheep walked the ramp to take their respective places on their social pyramid, with the Merino sheep at the top for its superior wool. We left, reeking of the barn after taking a selfie with the black sheep, frolicking with ducks, and feeding the endearing alpacas on the farm tour. Our otherworldly experiences in Rotorua culminated in conquering a Grade 5 rapid in the raging white waters of the Kaituna River before heading back to Auckland to board our flight to Queenstown.

"William, come here, honey. This lovely couple from India is visiting our favourite Cardrona Hotel (cardronahotel.co.nz)," an elderly woman with crinkled cheeks, highlighted with blush, called to her husband at a pit stop on the Crown Range Road. We had stopped to give in to the allure of the lupins, a beautiful weed that lines the roads of the South Island. As our road trip continued, we took in the late evening daylight on a coastal drive from Glenorchy to Queenstown. We visited the Gibbston Valley Winery to sample some wine in a rustic wine cave and stopped by a charming lavender farm run by an old Kiwi couple, who gently warned us about the bumblebees buzzing amid the lavender. Our senses, now somewhat jaded by all the breathtaking beauty of the past two weeks of travel, responded only to surreal vistas perceived from different travel perspectives. We marvelled at the urban silhouette of Queenstown merging with the mountainous terrain from the Skyline Gondola, and then zoomed in on the landscape from a luge cart. While Yash took

the plunge, leaping out of a plane to take in the aerial views of Queenstown, my acrophobic self was content navigating the rugged terrain in a high-velocity jetboat.

Indeed, the land is best viewed from the water, and we were captivated by the majestic fjords plunging into the sea, roaring waterfalls cascading with mist, dolphins flipping away, and sea lions sunbathing on boulders from aboard the Milford Sound Cruise boat. As we set off from Queenstown, we stopped by Lake Wanaka for a hearty Indian meal to soothe that twinge of homesickness, before making our way to Glacier Country.

We then took a helicopter ride to observe the Franz Josef Glacier up close, encountering a breathtaking glacier landing, and witnessing the glacial waters melt into the sea. While I thought nothing could surpass the stunning helicopter views, our final journey on the TranzAlpine train from Greymouth to Christchurch offered dramatic panoramas. During the unperturbed five-hour train ride, we gazed at the beauty of the Southern Alps, bore witness to the formation of deltas along the coast, and passed by the scenic Arthur's Pass National Park, pondering how life would unfold after our honeymoon. With tan lines from the fierce Antipodean sun and a stash of Whittaker's bars tucked away, we stepped onto our flight back to reality.

As Falguni Shane Peacock reaches a new milestone, the designer duo talk to SAMREEN TUNGEKAR about completing 20 years, launching their first prêt brand, and how travel influences their creativity

You launched your first exclusive prêtwear store. What did you want to highlight through this venture? This is our first prêt store, and we're really excited because it is born out of our travel to Italy last year, during this time. While we were there, we really felt that this is something that we should bring into our aesthetic, and so we brought a part, a slice of Italy to the brand's perspective.

20 years of Falguni Shane Peacock: How would you describe your journey in couture and fashion so far?

I think that 20 years is when you look back, and you realise that it's 20 whole years, you know? But for us, every day just feels like a new day. We feel like there's a lot more to achieve for us and for the brand, and there's a lot more things to leave back for fashion.



What are the biggest challenges for the fashion industry today?

That depends on how you see things, and what 'challenge' means to you. If you see them as challenges, there are a lot of challenges. We've always been competing with ourselves and we're trying to improve our brand, and take it to another level. We want to keep taking our brand a notch higher. There are no challenges that we face-we are very clear about what we want to do, and what we don't want to do. If we want to do something, we'll find a way. If not, we remove it out of our system. I think once you sit down and think and you know what you want, you know exactly where you're going and you know what you want to do, then nothing feels like a challenge.

What does travel mean to you?

Travel means everything. It opens up a different dimension. Sometimes we're very closed to a certain perspective, but when you travel it changes how you see something. You can be travelling within India or abroad—this change can happen anywhere; travel just inspires you to do many things. Be it the food, clothes, the way people dress, or by visiting storeswe're inspired by all of it. When we travel, we keep an open mind.

What are the cities that have inspired your creations?

I think at different times and years, and different time zones, we've been inspired by many things. There was a time when we were so taken in and inspired by Korean and Japanese influences. At that time, we launched the collection Colony. There were times when we were inspired by the Renaissance period. So I think it's just a matter what time, which year you are in, and you'll find a place that inspires you.

How do you see travel influence couture today especially when social media has made travel so accessible?

As an example: it's one thing to see food on social media, and another to go to a restaurant to eat it. There's a world of a difference-you may look at a channel and think you want to travel to Spain, but when you pack your bags and actually go to Spain, there's a world of a difference. Social media allows you to see the place beforehand or experience it in a different manner, but actual travel is a very different experience, so you just can't compare the two. Couture is the same way. If you're seeing couture firsthand—when you actually creating, making, and showing and meeting the people around you it's different-but when you see it on social media, it's not the same feeling. It's like some people love to read the book, while others prefer watching the movie.

What do you like doing when you travel for inspiration?

We just keep an open mind. There can be a poster stuck in the middle of the road or a saying written on the pavement, or a billboard that's put up that could inspire us. If you've visited our house, you'll see a lot of pictures of New York or London, clicked and framed. The inspiration is everywhere, you just have to find it.

If you're going for a holiday, what are five outfits you'll not miss out on?

When you're travelling, one thing is that you want to let loose. You want to be cool, chilled out, and you know that you're going to do a lot of walking. We walk a lot when we travel. So comfortable shoes are a must. I like to layer up, so it's usually a bomber jacket, a t-shirt, or a trench coat, and a good pair of jeans. Falguni likes to take good pictures, so she always packs things that are comfortable and look good in pictures.

Wedding Wows

With more than 150 weddings in his portfolio, Himanshu Patel of Epic Stories hardly needs an introduction. But when you cover what's been touted as the 'wedding of the century', it certainly adds a feather to the cap. He talks about the Ambani wedding, wanderlust, and how travel is impacting the world of wedding photography with MANSI SHAH

What are some of the challenges you faced, given the sheer scale and grandeur of the Anant Ambani-Radhika Merchant wedding?

I hadn't anticipated the scale of the wedding initially. We knew nine months prior to the wedding that we were shooting it, but we learned more details gradually. The most challenging aspect was managing the size and complexity of the events. It was vital to be prepared and vigilant in capturing raw and emotional moments while respecting the guests' privacy. Being discreet was of utmost


importance; we needed to be invisible yet present, capturing moments without disrupting anyone or interrupting the ceremonies. To achieve this, we strategically positioned each team member at key locations and minimised unnecessary movements during the ceremonies. We anticipated important moments and utilised telephoto lenses to capture intimate scenes from a distance, allowing us to get close-up shots without intruding. Although this shooting method is quite unusual for weddings, it's essential for professionals like us to adapt our techniques to meet specific expectations. This experience has reinforced the importance of being flexible and mindful of the unique needs of each event, enabling us to deliver the best possible results.

Take us through the debriefing process before the wedding. Did Radhika and Anant have a vision for their wedding pictures? Radhika and Anant had a clear vision.

They wanted to capture the tiny, intimate moments of fun, love, and emotion that would create beautiful memories for a lifetime. On our part, we got a thorough

understanding of the flow of each event, and we were able to anticipate key moments. We ensured we were in the right place at the right time, ready to capture spontaneous expressions of joy. The family had a special request: they wanted the photos to be cherished long after the memories faded, hoping these images would evoke the experiences and emotions of the day.





The main challenge is coordination. Logistics become complex when multiple locations are involved, from transporting equipment safely across borders to managing tight schedules and venue restrictions. Working in different time zones, languages, and weather conditions requires quick adaptability. Another significant challenge is ensuring consistency. Couples want cohesive storytelling that blends the different locations seamlessly, so I focus on maintaining a consistent style and narrative while adjusting to each place's unique qualities. Lastly, as each region has its customs and traditions, it's essential to approach every ceremony with cultural sensitivity and an understanding of the protocols to respect the families involved.

Taking off from that, what are some of the trends you're noticing when it comes to the wedding industry and travel?

Travel and wedding photography have become deeply intertwined, especially with the rise of destination weddings. Couples now look for unique and meaningful settings that reflect their stories, whether it's a palace in Rajasthan or a serene beach in the Maldives. These locations add an element of grandeur and cultural richness that's hard to recreate otherwise, transforming the wedding into a beautiful experience not only for the couple but also for the guests. Some trends we're seeing include destination themes that embrace local aesthetics and traditions, personalised to tell the couple's story. There's also a growing appreciation for editorial and documentary-style photography, where the focus is on high fashion and authentic emotions. Cultural fusion is another trendcouples often incorporate elements from the locale, creating a celebration that's both traditional and inspired by the destination.

How has social media impacted wedding photography? Could you tell us the pros and cons?

Instagram has had a huge impact on wedding photography, shaping how people

envision their weddings and the photos they want. In terms of pros, it's been amazing for exposure. Instagram allows photographers to reach a global audience and showcase their work instantly. It has also fuelled creativity, as couples are more willing to experiment with unique concepts they've seen online. The platform helps photographers gain recognition, especially for distinct styles, and clients are more likely to connect with us when they see our work and how it resonates with their vision. On

the downside, Instagram has created a bit of a "template" effect, where certain shots or themes become trends, and couples sometimes want those exact images, which can stifle creativity. There's also the pressure to capture "Insta-worthy" moments, often prioritising aesthetics over the natural flow of events. It can sometimes overshadow the authenticity of the experience itself. Social media also makes our work vulnerable to unauthorised use, with images often reshared without proper credit. ⊕



A Grand Egyptian Elopement


