- Sin is an individual problem. Ezekiel 18:1-4
- 3 case studies of Ezekiel 18:5-17.
- Conclusion? We are held accountable on an individual basis. Ezekiel 18:20
- People can change. Ezekiel 18:21-32
- NT teaching: 2 Cor. 5:10

My Sin is Your Problem

- Ezekiel 3:17-21.
- Ezekiel is set as a watchman to warn the people of danger.
- The watchman is obligated to sound the warning.
- It is a serious offense to be guilty of the blood of another. Acts 20:26, 27
- Gal. 6:1; James 5:19, 20; Jude 22, 23

My Sin is Our Problem

- Ezekiel 22:23-31
- Israel's leaders were corrupt.
- The people followed their lead. 22:29
- Ezekiel 22:31. All are held accountable.
- Contrast with Numbers 25:1-9.
- Lesson for us? 1 Cor. 5:5-8.
- Sin demands decisive action!
- Who will stand in the gap?
