Night, with Ebon Pinion

- **#162**
- **Ebon: a deep shade of black (ebony keys on a piano).**
- **Pinion: a bird's wing**
- **Brooded: to sit as a bird over eggs or young**
- **Vale: valley**
- **Night, like a dark wing, covered the valley (garden).**

- **Lyrics draw heavily from Ephesians 6:10-13.**
- **What is a “panoply”?**
- **A full suit of armor.**
 - **Ephesians 6:14-20**

- **#420**
- **A beautiful song that reminds us of God's goodness.**
- **What does the beginning of the second verse mean?**
 - **1 Samuel 7:2-12**
- **An Ebenezer is a "stone of help."**
- **The stone stood as a memorial of God's faithfulness and goodness to the children of Israel.**
