Would we feel comfortable asking others to imitate us?

What if everyone...?

- Ate and drank the Lord's Supper as you did? 1 Cor. 11:27-30
 - How many would be weak, ill, or dead?
 - Or, how many would feel compelled to Christ? 2 Cor. 5:14, 15
- Gave like you gave?
 - Not in terms of quantity, because that will vary (Lk. 21:1-4), but in terms of our attitude while giving (1 Cor. 16:2; 2 Cor. 8:1-5; 9:7).
 - If everyone imitated your attitude in giving, would the work of the church in benevolence cease or continue and prosper?

What if everyone...?

- Worked as hard as you worked spiritually?
 - If we all imitated you, would anyone hear the good news?
 - Romans 10:14, 15
 - You Never Mentioned Him To Me
- Prayed like you prayed?
 - Psalm 55:17; 1 Thessalonians 5:17
- Was as grateful as you are?
 - Luke 17:11-19
 - Or, what if everyone complained as often as you do? Phil.
 2:14, 15

What if...?

- God forgave like we forgave?
 - Matthew 18:21-35
 - Aren't we thankful God is better than that? Aren't we thankful He doesn't act like we act?
- Psalm 103:8-12
- Our forgiveness of others is to be modeled after the forgiveness Christ extended to us. Ephesians 4:32
